## Talking Trash

Effective October 20, 2009, the Town of Burrillville stopped curbside pick-up of mattresses and box springs

### Why:

Mattresses & box springs are recyclable, but when collected curbside they are processed as trash. This results not only in a cost to taxpayers (recently increased to \$50.00 for each item) but has impact on the environment.

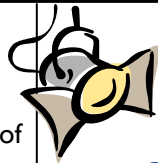
### Now what?

If possible, have old mattresses and box springs removed when new items are delivered; or

- Mattresses and box springs can be recycled at no cost
  - ◊ Bring mattresses and box springs to the Compost Facility during regular hours
  - ◊ Place in special container for recycling mattresses and box springs
  - ◊ Mattresses & box springs put out as trash will not be collected

Please take time to properly dispose of mattresses and box springs. Proper disposal not only reduces the amount of trash, it also saves tax dollars.

### Spay-Neuter Clinic for Cats

## Legal Beagle

Chapter 19 of Burrillville's Revised General Ordinances established a Town Redevelopment Agency (RA), with the purpose of encouraging, directing, and regulating new development and redevelopment within districts. A second purpose is to acquire and redevelop those areas itself, which the agency determines cannot be redeveloped otherwise. The town council determined that certain areas within the town suffer from blighted and substandard conditions, which require clearance, replanning, redevelopment, rehabilitations, improvement or a combination of these remedies. The Stillwater RA comprises 20 assessor's lots totaling 945,247.64 square feet or 21.70 acres in the Village of Harrisville. A second RA includes a district within downtown Pascoag. Using its various powers and duties of Article 19, the Burrillville Redevelopment Agency may retain controls and establish restrictions and covenants.
