Eligible to become, or to be currently registered as an Engineer-in-Training or Land Surveyor-in-Training in the State of Rhode Island or approved equal experience. Minimum of three (3) years experience in an engineering office in a municipal or a municipal related discipline is desired, which may include experience in a supervisory position in a private firm or related business, including the military. Must possess and maintain a valid driver's license. A surveyor's license is desirable.
