**With the ongoing construction on Route 107 in Harrisville (Chapel Street & East Avenue) the Burrillville Police Department recommends that motorists, especially students driving to the high school, seek alternate routes.**

**In an effort to ease the congestion on East Avenue the police department recommends that motorists use either Lapham Farm Road or Central Street to access Route 102 (Broncos Highway). High school students are advised to use Route 102 to East Avenue to access the high school entrance.**

**East Avenue will be open to local traffic and emergency vehicles at all times during construction. There will be police officers posted at the intersection of Harrisville Main Street & East Avenue and at the entrance to the high school, to ease traffic congestion during the morning commute and while students, teachers and staff are arriving at the high school.**

**The town and school administration, Laidlaw Bus Company, D'Ambra Construction and the Burrillville Police Department are working together to make the morning commute as smooth as possible.**
