| Mixed Paper | Mail, envelopes- (windows OK) Magazines, catalogs Phonebooks Writing/ledger paper Paperbacks Paper bags Greeting cards Wrapping paper Shredded paper Fax paper Computer paper Hard cover books with covers removed | Place in green bin. All mixed paper & thin cardboard can be mixed together. Place shredded paper in paper bags first. | No paper towels, facial tissues, napkins No cigarette packs No candy wrappers No waxed or plastic coated paper No wrapping tissue paper No foil wrapping paper |
| Newspapers | All newspapers, ads & inserts | Place in brown paper bag or tie with string. | Do NOT put in a plastic bag |
| Thin Cardboard | Shoe boxes Cereal boxes Pasta boxes (windows OK) Toilet paper rolls Paper towel rolls Gift boxes Cake mix boxes Toothpaste boxes Tissue boxes Paper egg cartons | Place in green bin with mixed paper, but throw away package plastic or wax liners. | No take-out or frozen food boxes No soda or beer packaging No soap or laundry detergent boxes No boxes with silver or foil coatings Nothing dirty, greasy or plastic coated |
| Corrugated Cardboard | Boxes Other corrugated cardboard (smooth on the outside, wavy in the middle) | Small boxes go right in bin. Flatten larger pieces. Boxes must be cut into 3ft x 3ft widths or smaller. Tie bundles with string and place next to bin. | No cardboard larger than 3ft No dirty or greasy cardboard NO pizza boxes |
