Broncos Highway Solar/Going Green Realty, AP 113 Lot 11: Master Plan review, Major Land Development Solar Project, 750 kW AC 985 kW DC 91,500+/- square feet canopy solar array, no road, accessed via an existing driveway off of Broncos Highway. Public Informational Meeting.

Both incorrectly listed the lot number as lot 11. After conferring with attorney for the project, Jennifer Cervenka and the Town Solicitor, William Dimitri, a continuance to February 3, 2020 is recommended to allow for correct notice to be circulated. A motion to continue Douglas Pike Solar, LLC, 0 Walling Road, Map 131 Lot 7: Master Plan review / Public Informational Meeting to February 3, 2020 meeting was made by Mr. Ferreira, seconded by Mr. Foy and carried unanimously by the board.

Harrisville Village/MBVB Developers, AP 160 Lot 34: Bond reduction request for completion of road construction/final coat of paving.

Mr. Goff explained that the developer, Mark Bard, has requested a bond reduction for completed road/paving work. The work was reviewed by town engineer, Jeff McCormick who then recommended

a \$25,000 reduction. Mr. Ferreira asked if the developer fixed any of the previously identified issues. Mr. Goff stated that most of the concerns have been addressed. There will be \$59,000 remaining in the bond to cover the remaining construction work.

A motion to reduce the \$84,000 bond by \$25,000 to \$59,000 was made by Mr. Partington, seconded by Mr. Pick and carried unanimously by the board.
