HOLIDAY REFUSE & RECYCLING INFORMATION



HOLIDAY RECYCLING GUIDE

Christmas trees can be brought to the Whipple Ave Recycling & Compost Facility the first two weeks in January from 9-1 on Wednesday and Saturday. Trees must be free of all ornaments & tinsel. Plastic bags are NOT accepted.



Wrapping paper and paper from gift bags can be placed in your recycle cart. Foil paper, ribbons & bows are trash.

Gift boxes and large cardboard boxes can be broken down and placed in your recycle cart or brought to the Whipple Ave Recycling & Compost Facility.

Electronic waste and TVs can be brought to the Whipple Ave Recycling & Compost Facility.

Styrofoam (foodservice and rigid packing foam) can be brought to RIRRC. Call 942-1430 for more information.

Plastic shopping bags and bubble wrap can be brought the RE:store bin at IGA in Pascoag.

Use a Wood Stove or Pellet Stove ?

Pellet bags and the plastic overwrap from wood bundles can be brought to the RE:store bin at IGA in Pascoag.



Old fireplace tools can be brought to the Whipple Ave Recycling & Compost Facility.

Wood ash & charred wood are not accepted in your recycling cart. Store ashes in a metal container with a metal cover.

Holiday Trash DELAYS:

There will be no Trash or Recycling pickup on Christmas Day or New Year's Day (12/25/15 and 1/1/16). Pickups will be delayed one day for the remainder of those weeks.

WINTER COLLECTION REMINDERS

Extreme Cold: Freezing temperatures can cause trash/recycling to freeze to side of the carts preventing them from being fully emptied. Make sure trash is bagged and recyclables are rinsed and dry. Keep cart lids closed and be sure to dump out snow/rain that may have accumulated in cart after it was emptied.

Snow Storms: If the storm will occur in the overnight hours, wait until the morning to place your carts curbside; this will reduce chances of carts being knocked over by slush from plow trucks. Extreme storms that span the majority of the daylight hours or that predict 6+ inches of snow and/or high winds may require an earlier collection time. Please place carts out by 6am for these extreme weather events.
