

	Budget Board submits Capital Improvement Budget (CIP) recommendation to Town Manager
March 6, 2023	(Date required by Ordinance is first Monday of March - Ordinance §2-112 (d) - March 6, 2023)
	Budget Board submits FYE2024 Operating Budget recommendations to Town Manager
April 3, 2023	(Charter Due Date is first Monday in April - Charter §10.05(B))
April 5, 2023	Public Notice of the Public Hearing on Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget
April 6, 2023	Manager submits his Capital Improvement Budget (CIP) recommendation to the Town Council
	7:00 p.m. Public Hearing – CIP Program
	Adoption of FYE2024 CIP Program & update of the 5-Year Plan
April 12, 2023	(Ordinance deadline is April 15, 2023 - Ordinance §2-112 (g))
April 19, 2023	Town submits budget data and ads to the State for review and approval.
	Manager submits his Operating Budget recommendations to the Town Council
May 1, 2023	(Charter Due Date: First Monday in May – Charter §10.05(C))
	Last Date that three (3) ads need to appear advising the public of the proposed budget,
	proposed tax changes, and dates of public hearings. The final ad needs to appear at least ten
May 8, 2023	(10) days before the first public hearing. (Charter §10.05(E))
May 18, 2023	7:00 p.m. 1st Public Hearing – Municipal Budget
May 25, 2023	7:00 p.m. 2nd Public Hearing – School Budget
June 1, 2023	7:00 p.m Additional Public Hearing Date (if necessary)
June 14, 2023	7:00 p.m Budget Adoption (1st Council Meeting in June) (Charter §10.05(F))
June 28, 2023	7:00 p.m Final Budget Adjustments (if necessary) (2nd Council Meeting in June)
July 1, 2023	New Fiscal Year begins

Council Workshops	May be scheduled as needed before or after the Public Hearings.
We have reserved the first week of June for workshops unless there are other dates to consider.	
Line Item Veto	Manager may veto any item within seventy-two hours.
Charter §10.05(G)	Council may override the veto by affirmative vote of four (4) members
Voter Initiative	Referendum on changes to department budgets may be held upon the petition of fifteen
Charter §10.05(I)	percent (15%) of the voters.
