Burrillville Town Council Resolution

- WHEREAS, Spectra Energy has proposed an infrastructure investment that expands the pipeline capacity of the existing Algonquin Gas Transmission system; and
- WHEREAS, the pipeline would transport natural gas obtained through hydraulic fracturing, a drilling method well known for its potential for ground water contamination, impact on air quality, and the harmful health effects of its chemical byproducts, among others; and
- WHEREAS, a gas pipeline, by its nature, carries the potential for leak, rupture or explosion causing potential damage to property and lives; and
- WHEREAS, said pipeline could impact unknowable amounts of forest, wetlands, conservation land and farmland; and
- WHEREAS said pipeline could adversely affect property values, adversely affect residents' livelihood and otherwise negatively impact the integrity of the town's bucolic character; and
- WHEREAS, energy challenges through investments in energy conservation measures as well as green and renewable energy solutions should be thoroughly evaluated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Town Council of the Town of Burrillville do hereby stand in opposition to The Access Northeast Project, an infrastructure investment that expands the pipeline capacity of the existing Algonquin Gas Transmission system.
